Historical geography of the last two centuries. Introduction to the school of thoughts in historical geography. Maps and cartography in a historical perspective. Imperialism and expansion. Borders and security. Spatial identities from empires to states. Nations and nationalism. Symbolisms of nation in art. Landscapes and national landscapes. Nations and nationalism. War and death landscapes. Migratory movements and forced migration during peace or war time respectively. Urban landscape and urbanization. Religions, languages, education systems and identities. Minorities and political space. Exclusions and spatial inequalities in a globalized space.
